**Maintenance and modifications to the permit tracking database were part of a longer-term effort to serve permit reviews on the VIMS CCRM web site. (<http://www.vims.edu/ccrm/wetlands/newpermits.html>) Permit reviews were made available on the web site for the first time in January 2001. Five computer-based elements: GPS, digital photography, Sybase, word processing and ArcView/ArcInfo are required in order to produce the electronic permit review reports. The system is currently semi-automated but requires staff interaction on a daily basis. Continual data entry is required. Minor adjustments continue to be made to ensure accuracy and consistency.**
